1. 'To recognise features of a setting description' You may need to look at some of the guidance for last week's English learning to help you with this which is on the website. Task 1: Using the example setting description in the *English Guidance* to create a success criteria for writing a setting description. Task 2: Create a word bank of key vocabulary to use in your setting description.
2. 'To sequence events in chronological order'. Use a Story Mountain to Sequence Events in Chronological Order. See Lesson Resources for a *Writing Template* to support you with your learning.
3. 'To identify different word types.' Refer to the English Guidance and Video Tutorial to help you to identify different word types such as adjectives, nouns, verbs, adverbs and conjunctions.
4. 'To write an adventure story'. Use the success criteria that you have developed throughout your learning this week and watch the Video Tutorial to support you in developing ideas for your own adventure story based on your reading of 'Claude in the City'.

4. 'To add two 3 digit numbers.' Practise the skills by completing 'Worksheet 5- Simple Adding' in the *Maths Guidance*.
