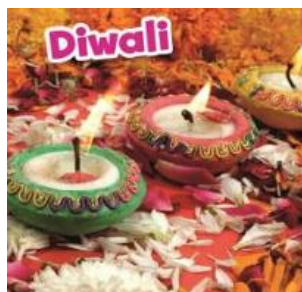


## English
