- ❖ Can you retell the story? Retell the story film it and put it on Tapestry.

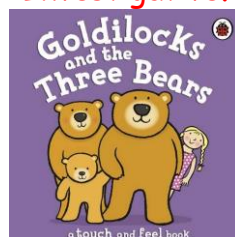
Creative
